ONLINE OMNIBUS RESULTS

Field dates: September 17 - 19, 2013

Total sample size: 1,007 adult Canadians (18+)

1. In Canada, almost all egg laying hens are housed in bare, wire cages known as "battery cages," which give hens less space than an average sheet of writing paper per bird. Because of animal welfare problems associated with battery cages, Canadian egg producers are researching alternative housing systems.
