STOP INTERNATIONAL DOLPHIN TRAFFICKING.

THESE DOLPHINS DIDN'T MAKE IT to dolphin shows or swim-with-dolphins attractions at fancy resorts around the world. Instead they ended up in a garbage dump in the Solomon Islands, victims of a growing worldwide trade in wild dolphins orchestrated by greedy wildlife traffickers.

The cruel and deadly market for wild dolphins is growing, fueled by the popularity of dolphin sideshows and swim-with attractions. With a going price of as much as \$200,000 per dolphin, unscrupulous operators are capturing and shipping dolphins wherever they can, and merely paying lip service to international laws whenever they have to. Many dolphins die in the process.

These dolphin hunts often occur in small villages like Taiji, Japan, or developing countries like the Solomon Islands, which lack the political will or resources to monitor and protect their wildlife.

It is time for all governments around the world to take responsibility and prohibit

the import of dolphins from these inhumane dolphin trafficking operations.

Right now, the dolphin traffickers operating in the Solomon Islands, who have already sent dozens of dolphins to Mexico and Dubai, are planning to airfreight more wild-caught dolphins to theme parks around the world — including Singapore, and possibly Panama and the Dominican Republic. You can help stop them.

Only a public outcry now will help put an end to this cruel dolphin trade, and keep more dead dolphins from landing in the dump.
